CALL FOR PAPERS on "**The European Banking Union**"

Spanish Review of Financial Economics (SRFE)

The Spanish Review of Financial Economics (SRFE) is now soliciting papers for a special issue in the SRFE to appear in March 2015 on the topic of "The European Banking Union". This issue will count with confirmed contributions by Vice-President of the European Central Bank, Vitor Constancio, and the Deputy Governor of the Bank of Spain, Fernando Restoy.

The current state of the European banking system and the regulatory response by national and European monetary policy and regulatory authorities has put the European Banking Union at the forefront of policy, academic and practitioner debate. The heterogeneous national responses to the failure of European banks during the financial crisis has led to a higher level of fragmentation of the Single Market in lending and funding. A Banking Union with centralised mechanisms for the supervision and restructuring of European banks is currently emerging in the European landscape to foster financial stability and growth in the euro area. In this context, we are seeking to publish papers in a special issue of the SRFE which will cover the following topics related to the European Banking Union:

- Single Supervisory Mechanism
- Single Resolution Mechanism
- Mutual borrowing between the national Deposit Guarantee Schemes
 - Bank recapitalisation and EU backstops
 - Macroeconomic impact of the European banking union
- Asset pricing implications for banks in the European banking union
- Regulatory challenges in the European Banking Union

The editors invite drafts of papers for publication in this special issue. Proposals should be submitted electronically to Antonio Moreno, Executive Editor of SRFE, no later than November 5, 2014 at antmoreno@unav.es. The editors will make the final selection of papers to be included in the special issue. The papers should represent original research not published elsewhere. Since the papers are intended for publication, authors will not be able to publish or reprint the work elsewhere without the permission of the editors and publisher. Please note that the editors will contact potential authors only if their paper is accepted.
